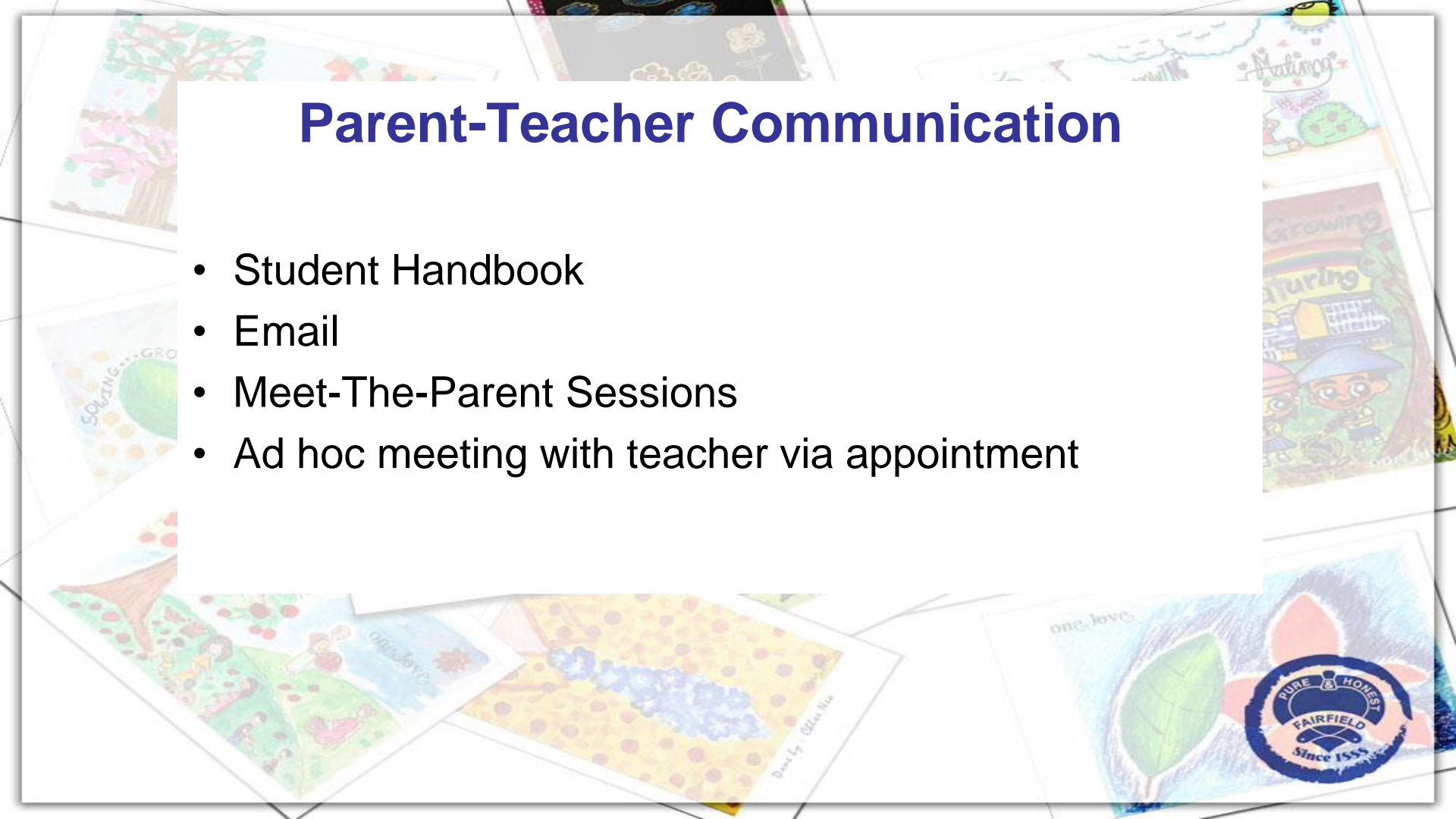

# A New Beginning

- **Snack Time**

- 2<sup>nd</sup> meal break
- Around 12pm (10 min)
- Venue: classroom
- Simple dry snack (eg. bread, fruits, biscuits)



# Traffic along Dover Road

- Heavy traffic is expected during reporting and dismissal times
- No vehicular entry to school during dismissal time
  - \*1pm to 1.45pm (dismissal 1)
  - \*3.45pm to 4.15pm (dismissal 2)
- No parking or waiting in school
- Use the multi-storey car park next to FMSS (Blk 2A, Dover Road) and walk over

- Parents are to pick up your child from the **Gate 1** if he/she is going home by foot.

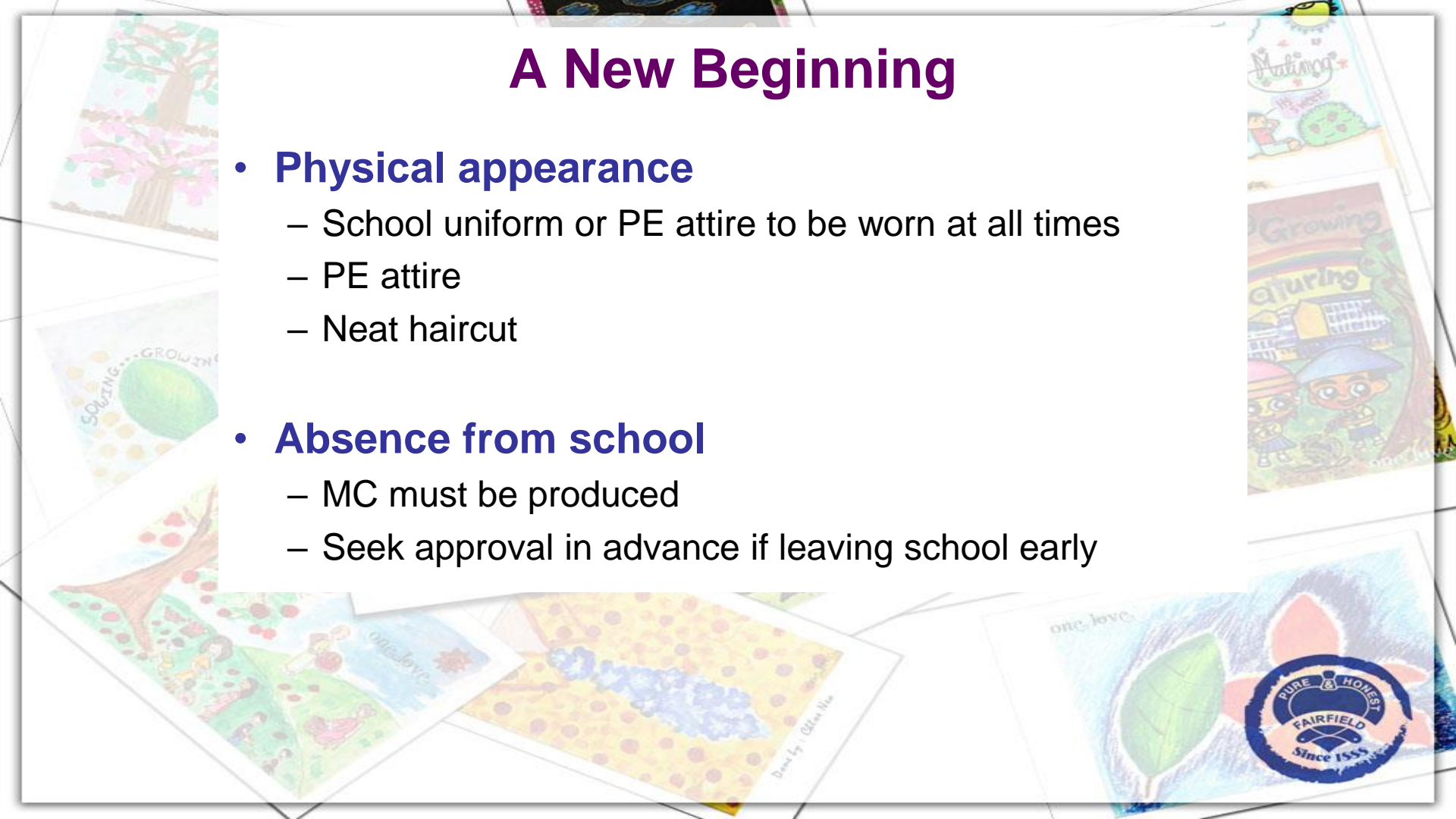
# A New Beginning

- **Physical appearance**

- **Absence from school**

- MC must be produced
- Seek approval in advance if leaving school early

**In primary school, your child will be equipped with skills to:**

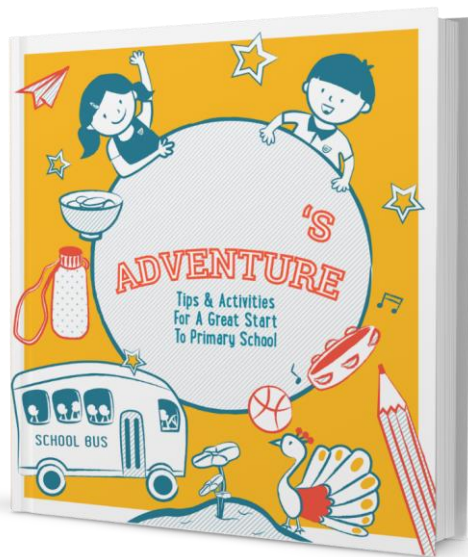
- Adjust to a larger learning environment
